CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

OF

MOHONK PRESERVE, INC.

Under Section 402 of the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under Section 402 of the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law, hereby certifies:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is:

MOHONK PRESERVE, INC.

SECOND: The corporation is a corporation as defined in subparagraph (a)(5) of Section 102 of the Not-For-Profit Corporation Law.

THIRD: The purposes for which the corporation is to be formed are:

- (a) To advance knowledge and understanding of nature, the natural environment, and the relationships of men, women and children to nature;
- (b) To create an environment in which the public may be educated in the purposes and importance of natural processes and natural resources, and in which men, women and children may be morally and mentally improved, sustained and enriched through such education and through their active

and passive contacts with nature; and

(c) To carry on research and other educational activities relating to such environment and to the study, improvement, management and preservation of all forms of life.

To further these purposes, and not by way of limitation of any of its lawful powers, the corporation may:

- A. Acquire, by gift, purchase or otherwise, real and personal property, both tangible and intangible, of every sort and description and interests in such real and personal property, and use such property and the net earnings thereof, including the proceeds of the sale thereof in such manner as the Trustees of the corporation shall deem appropriate to carry out one or more of the above purposes except that the Trustees shall not sell real property where the donor shall have provided by appropriate deed or other recordable restriction that the same shall not be sold; and
- B. Receive, by gift or otherwise, and hold or otherwise deal, act with respect to, land or interests in land, subject to special restrictions authorized by the law of the State of New York.

Nothing herein shall authorize this corporation, directly or indirectly, to engage in or include among its purposes, any of the activities mentioned in Not-for-Profit Corporation Law, Section 404(b)-(t).

FOURTH: The corporation is a Type B corporation.

FIFTH: The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as charitable or educational organizations exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ration shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein. No part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this certificate, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3)

of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.)

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, SEVENTH: the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable or educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Supreme Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

EIGHTH: The office of the corporation is to be city And located in the County of New York.

This waiver of consent to filing is granted with the understanding that nothing contained in the annexed document shall be construed as authorizing the corporation to engage in the practice of law, except as provided by subdivision 5 of section 495 of the Judiciary Law, or of any of the professions designated in Title VIII of the Education Law, or to use any title restricted by such law, or to conduct a school for any such profession, or to hold itself out to the public as offering professional services.

This waiver of consent to filing is granted with the further understanding that nothing contained in the annexed document shall be construed as authorizing the corporation to operate a nursery school, kindergarten, elementary school, secondary school, institution of higher education, cable television facility, educational television station pursuant to section 236 of the Education Law, library, museum, or historical society, or to maintain an historic site.

This waiver of consent to filing shall not be deemed to be or to take the place of registration for the operation of a private business school in accordance with the provisions of section 5002 of the Education Law, nor shall it be deemed to be, or to take the place of, a license granted by the Board of Regents pursuant to the provisions of section 5001 of the Education Law, a license granted by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles pursuant to the provisions of section 394 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, a license as an employment agency granted pursuant to section 172 of the General Business Law, or any other license, certificate, registration, or approval required by law.
