Weather Summary for July, 2016

Highest temperature: $90^{\circ}F$ on the 4^{th} and $22^{nd} - 24^{th}$ Lowest temperature: $58^{\circ}F$ on the 2^{nd} and 11^{th}

Fog: 5 days (5th, 8th-9th, 14th, and 31st)

Thunder: 9 days (1st-2nd, 7th, 9th, 14th, 18th-19th, and 25th-26th)

Haze: 9 days (6th-8th, 12th, 14th-15th, 22nd, 29th-30th)

Misting: 1 day (14th)

Precipitation pH: 5.19 (n=13)

Summary

Temperature for July was 3.4°F above the 120-year average, marking this July to be the 10th warmest July on record (see Table 1). Precipitation was 6.63 in., 2.12 inches above normal. There were 14 recorded days of measurable precipitation (Average is 10.9).
