Summary

Temperature for October was 1.3°F above the 120-year average. Three daily temperature records were recorded for October: October 18th at 79°F (78°F in 1908), October 19th at 79°F (77°F in 1963), and October 20th at 75°F (74°F in 1947). Precipitation was 3.81 in., 0.15 inches below normal. Monthly snowfall was 1.00 in., 0.73 inches above normal.

There were 13 recorded days of measurable precipitation (Average is 9.2).

The first frost occurred on the 26^{th} of October, 4 days later than average (October 22^{nd}), making the 2016 growing season a total of 182 days (average is 180 days).
