Weather Summary for April, 2017

Snow on Ground: There was no snow on the ground for the month of April.

Precipitation pH: 4.89 (n=9)

Summary

Temperature for April was 7.4°F above the 121-year average, marking 2017 the second warmest April on record (see Table 1). Precipitation was 4.68 in., 0.58 inches above normal. There were 12 recorded days of measurable precipitation (Average is 12.8). Monthly snowfall was 0.00 inches, 2.91 inches below normal. Lake ice ended on the 7th, 1.5 days later than the 84 - year average.
