Summary

Temperature for July was 4.0°F above the 122-year average, marking this the 9th warmest July on record (Table 1). Precipitation was 9.27 in., 4.75 inches above average, marking this the 5th rainiest July on record (Table 2). There were 10 recorded days of measurable precipitation (Average is 10.7).
