## Summary

Temperature for July was 4.0°F above the 122-year average, marking this the 9<sup>th</sup> warmest July on record (Table 1). Precipitation was 9.27 in., 4.75 inches above average, marking this the 5<sup>th</sup> rainiest July on record (Table 2). There were 10 recorded days of measurable precipitation (Average is 10.7).
