Weather Summary for September, 2018

Thunder: 3 days (6th, 12th, 18th)

Precipitation pH: 4.93 (n= 13)

Summary

Temperature for September was 2.7°F above the 122-year average. Precipitation was 12.70 in., 8.36 inches above average, marking this the rainiest September on record (Table 1). There were 14 recorded days of measurable precipitation (Average is 9.26).
