Summary

Temperature for November was 6.7°F above the 124-year average, marking this the 3rd warmest November on record (Table 1). Precipitation was 1.54 inches above average. Snowfall was 3.27 inches below average. There were 10 recorded days of measurable precipitation (Average is 10.2).
