Summary


Temperature for the month was 7.8°F above the 114 year average, ranking this the 4^{th} warmest March on record (see table and graph on Page 2). A daily high temperature was set on the 19th at 67°F (previous high temperature for that date was 63°F, set in 1925). Precipitation for the month was 8.25 in., 105% above normal, ranking this the 7th wettest March (see table and graph on Page 2). A daily precipitation record was set on the 23rd at 2.39 in. of rain (previous high for that date was 1.30 in. set in 1903).

Snowfall for the month was 2.3 in., 80% below normal. A daily snow on ground record was set on the 1st with 32 in. of snow on ground (previous record for the date was 29 in. set in 1978). Ice off on the 30th was 8 days earlier than the 74 year average date and 81 days of ice cover was 23 days shorter than average.


