

Lake Ice: 100% cover on the 1st- 28th. 10 inches thick (clear water ice) off the Boat

Precipitation pH: 5.02 (n=3)

Summary

Temperature for the month was 1.4°F above the 117-year average. No daily temperature or precipitation records were set. Twelve days of measureable precipitation were recorded (average is 9). Snowfall for the month was 8% above normal.
