Weather Summary for July, 2014

Thunder: 7 days (2nd—4th, 7th, 9th, 14th, 28th)

Precipitation pH: 4.87 (n=11)

Summary

Temperature for the month was 0.1°F above average. Precipitation was 2.88 inches above average. 13 days of measurable precipitation were recorded (average is 11 days). Daily precipitation records were set on July 2nd, with 2.03 inches of rainfall exceeding the previous record of 1.84 inches set in 1986, and on July 4th, with 2.05 inches of rain surpassing the previous record of 1.76 inches in 1908.
