Weather Summary for July, 2023

Summary*

Temperature for July was 74.1°F, 3.0°F above the 127-year average. Precipitation was 9.01 in., 4.48 inches above average, marking this the seventh wettest July in our recorded history (Table 1). There were 17 recorded days of measurable precipitation (Average is 12).
